Career academy ushers in opportunities

School system, students excited for facility's Aug. 2012 completion

Construction is about to begin on the new Liberty College and Career Academy on Airport Road, according to Liberty County School System Superintendent Dr. Judy Scherer. Prep work began in February when community leaders and dignitaries broke ground on the site following a luncheon at the Liberty County Board of Education Transportation Complex.

At the event, the Liberty County Chamber of Commerce welcomed guest speaker Lt. Gov. Casey Cagle, who spoke about his support for career academies in Georgia.

Cagle said he was excited about the much-anticipated LCCA, which will be just minutes from the school system's dual-enrollment partner in the endeavor, Savannah Technical College.

"Not every child is going to college," he reminded the audience. "(But) that doesn't mean they aren't going to be successful. Eighty percent of the jobs of tomorrow need some technical training."

The career academy will allow students to earn technical-college credit while still in high school, and the facility is expected to open in August 2012. Currently, there are 23 career academies across Georgia, Cagle said.

Educators, administrators and Liberty County Board of Education members repeatedly have expressed excitement about the academy's construction, its addition to the Liberty County School System and the support they have received from the governor.

"Lt. Gov. Cagle has been an avid supporter of the career academy concept and has worked to obtain money for construction of new academies from the general assem-

bly for several years," Scherer said. "It is fitting and certainly an honor for us to have him present for the groundbreaking ceremony."

Although times have been tough, according to the governor, he believes the changes that are coming through the state and federal governments will have a positive impact on the nation and the education system.

"We're excited about the future of education," Cagle said. "We've got challenges in the budget. We really have to focus on what we need to be spending our money on."

BoE board member Charlie Frasier said the career academy has been a long time coming and is something he has seen other counties have luck with.

"We think it's a good thing.

We've been patient about it," Frasier said. "Our final vote was 'Let's do it.' Everybody on the school board was in agreement ... from what we hear, it works out real well."

Because construction was pushed back a bit due to complications with the building location, a school-within-a-school concept will be utilized to get students enrolled in courses before construction is finished, which will get the program going, Scherer said.

Career Academy CEO Tom Alexander is looking forward to seeing the finished product.

"The more work I've done on this, the more excited I become about this. This is going to be a really good thing for our kids," he said. "There's a place out there for everybody; we just have to help them find it."

Classes at Liberty County schools will resume Aug. 4. The last day of school is May 31.

The schedule is in line with last year's start and end dates and is similar to those in nearby counties: Long County classes begin Aug. 5 and end May 16, and Bryan County classes resume Aug. 3 and end May 18.

Chatham County schools, however, start Aug. 22 and end June 8.

School officials say that the longer school years — early start dates and later end dates — allow for more holidays and half days and also allow for a greater learning capacity.

Research has proven that if students don't refresh recently learned information over the summer, they tend to lose it completely. This often causes schools to spend two or three months re-teaching lost knowledge. As a result, shorter summers may lead to a greater retention of information.

1. Your infant may not need a dose of HepB at age 4 months depending on the type of vaccine that your healthcare provider uses.
 2. Your infant may not need a dose of Hib vaccine or RV vaccine at age 6 months depending on the type of vaccine that your healthcare provider uses.
 3. One dose is recommended for most people. Children younger than age 9 years who are receiving influenza vaccine for the first time, or who received only 1 dose in the previous season (if it was their first vaccination season), should receive 2 doses spaced at least 4 weeks apart this season.
 4. This dose of DTaP may be given as early as 12 months if it has been 6 months since the previous dose and you think you might not return for more shots by the time your child is age 18 months.
 5. If your child's vaccinations are delayed or missed entirely, they should be given as soon as possible.
 6. All girls and women age 11 through 26 years should be vaccinated with 3 doses of HPV vaccine, given over a 6-month period. (Girls as young as age 9 years may be vaccinated.)
 7. If you have a teenager who is enrolling in college and planning to live in a dormitory and hasn't previously been vaccinated against meningococcal disease, they should be vaccinated now.
Please note: Some children may need additional vaccines. Talk to your healthcare provider.

LCSS releases free and reduced-price meals policy

Liberty County School System recently released its policy for free- and reduced-price meals for children under the national school lunch program and/or school breakfast program. Local school officials have adopted the following family size and income criteria for determining eligibility:

For each additional family member, add \$4,966 per year to the income level for free meals and \$7,067 to the income level for reduced-price meals.

Reduced-price breakfast for elementary, middle and high school is 30 cents. Full-price breakfast is \$1 for elementary school and \$1.25 for middle and high schools.

Reduced-price lunch for elementary, middle and high school is 40 cents. Full-price lunch is \$1.55 for elementary school and \$1.80 for middle and high schools.

Applications are available at the schools and online at www.liberty.k12.ga.us/nutrition/forms

Please ensure your child has money in his or her lunch account for the first day of school, which is Aug. 4.

To apply for free or reduced price meals, households should fill out one application per family and return it to the school nutrition clerk in the school cafeteria or take it to the board of education building at 200 Bradwell St. in Hinesville. Children from families whose income is at or below the levels shown are eligible for free or reduced-price meals once an application is completed and processed. Foster children also may be eligible for these meals. Families with foster children may include the foster children and other children in the household on one family application. Additional applications are available at the front office in each school. The information provided on the application will be used for the purpose of determining eligibility and may be verified at any time. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year when family income changes or family size changes.

Administration: Drivers, beware buses

With the school year drawing near, administrators want to remind drivers that buses — and pedestrian students — need special attention on the road.

“We have a huge problem of people blowing the lights — that’s what we call it,” said Tony Norce, director of transportation for the Liberty County Board of Education, about drivers who pass buses while they are loading and unloading passengers.

“One of my buses was going down 196 and put the amber lights on and then the red lights on preparing to drop a student off in the afternoon, and a log truck came flying by — it couldn’t stop in time,” Norce said, recalling an incident from last year. “And (the truck) hit the stop sign that sticks out from the side of the bus and bent it backwards.”

This spring, Liberty County took part in a single-day study conducted throughout 28 states and counted 148 passes. Most of these problems occur on highways 196 and 84.

“That’s huge, considering I only run 139 routes, so we’re averaging one pass per route,” Norce said. “So there’s the potential on every route every day for a child to be hurt by a motorist.”

Drivers nationwide fail to stop in alarming rates, according to the study by the National Association of State Directors of Pupil Transportation Services.

About 112,000 drivers in each state recorded a single-day snapshot of how frequently motorists passed their buses illegally while the buses were stopped.

In all, the drivers reported 37,756 passes during the one-day study, the report said. Though data from all states was not available, “in

a typical 180-day school year, the 76,685 vehicles that passed school buses illegally represent well over 13 million violations by private motorists,” the report said.

The majority of these violations — 61.8 percent — were offenders passing from the front of the bus, while 38.2 percent passed from behind. Of the reported passes, 96.9 percent were on the left side of the bus, while 3.1 percent were on the right side of the bus.

“It’s unfortunate, but that 3 percent on the right are the ones that have the higher chance of being catastrophic because that’s where the kids are lining up and getting off the bus,” Norce said.

Opposing-traffic violations pose a threat to children who are forced to cross the street, he added. To reduce these threats, the county always routes the buses for right-hand pickups on major roads.

“When those lights are on, the drivers should assume there is going to be the possibility that kids are crossing,” he said.

According to Georgia code, fines for passing a stopped bus can range up to \$1,000, and the Department of Drivers Services adds six points to a driver’s record.

Within Hinesville city limits, drivers who fail to stop for a bus while it is loading or unloading face a \$286 fine, according to the city’s Municipal Court fine fees site.

A driver cited by a Liberty County Sheriff’s Deputy would face a \$444 fine, according to Capt. David Edwards.

In Midway, the fine is \$500, Municipal Court Clerk Donna Davis said.

The easiest way to reduce these unsafe and potentially costly practices, Norce said, is to “just be alert for the lights.”

Liberty County schools' registration guidelines

Parents can register a new student for school at the school site in their attendance zone.

Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2011. First-grade students must be 6 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2011.

Sixth-grade students must provide proof of second MMR and second varicella vaccine/immunity

For initial registration of students in all grades, bring all of these items with you to expedite the process:

- Georgia Cert. of Immunization (Form 3231)
- Georgia Certificate of Ear, Eye, and Dental Screening (Form 3300)
- Social Security card
- Evidence of date of birth: certified birth certificate; mil-

itary ID; valid driver’s license; passport; adoption record; religious record signed by an authorized religious official; official school transcript; or if none of the aforementioned items can be produced, an affidavit of age sworn by the parent or guardian accompanied by a certificate of age signed by a licensed practicing physician, which states that the physician has examined the child and believes that the age as stated in the affidavit is substantially correct.

• Two proofs of residence: The school will accept a current utility bill (water, gas, electric, local home phone, cable, etc.) and any one of the following items: current lease/rental agreement; most recent income tax return;

current paycheck stub; current Medicaid card; current residential property tax statement or bill; current warranty or quick claim deed; current home purchase agreement; third-person affidavit of residency (while in the presence of a school official a notarized statement shall be completed and signed by parent or guardian, as well as the legal owner or lessor of the property where the student and the parent, guardian or other person reside); or current homeowner’s insurance policy.

Proof of enrollment and attendance (report card/school transcript) in an accredited school, plus school address, must be presented if registering during the 2011-12 school year.

Tax-free shopping debate continues

As in 2010, Ga. will not offer weekend savings this year

Because of three stalled bills, Georgia did not offer a tax-free weekend in 2010, so many residents either couldn't participate or drove to Florida, Tennessee, Alabama or South Carolina to partake in their tax-free weekends. Georgia will not have a tax-free weekend this year, either. However, some legislators did try to bring it back.

Some people fear that tax-free weekends may never return; and if some legislators have their way, it may not.

"It's giving up revenue, and frankly, I always viewed it as if Georgians want that over keeping schoolhouse doors open and troopers on the road," Speaker David Ralston, R-Blue Ridge, said in March 2010 as budget negotiations increased. "What I hear Georgians say is they'd rather have their classroom teachers in the classroom

teaching than have that sales holiday."

But Georgia also was one of the few states to implement a tax-free weekend, and its creator believes that it should be reinstated.

After watching his wife drive back and forth to Florida to shop during its tax-free weekend, Sen. Tim Golden proposed the sales holiday to Georgia's Legislature.

"This year, of all years, people need it," said Golden, D-Valdosta, during an interview in 2010. "Retailers need the boost more than ever and families need the boost more than ever."

Teachers are feeling the pinch as well, which is why many of them want tax-free weekends to return. Teachers in both private and public schools often have to buy their own classroom materials every summer. In previous years, the tax-free weekend could create some serious savings for teachers. But without the sales holiday,

teachers are spending more of their own money just to make sure they have enough supplies for their students.

The main reason the Georgia Legislature didn't pass the tax-free bills was because it couldn't afford the revenue lost in tax dollars while the state is \$2 billion in debt. Legislators have said that Georgia lost around \$13 million in revenue during the tax-free weekend in 2009.

However, many retailers argue that there aren't any revenue losses during tax-free weekend. On the contrary, they claim there is a major revenue spike.

The Georgia Retail Association claims that revenue increases by \$20 million during tax-free weekends. If the estimate is accurate, it could help reduce the sizeable debt.

John Heavner of the GRA said he wants to show the Legislature that the revenue spike is real and that Georgia actually would make money if tax-free weekends are rein-

stated.

As he pointed out, Florida reinstated its tax-free weekend after a two-year break and actually made money. So, the hope is that the same would prove true for Georgia. Then people wouldn't have to cross state lines to take advantage of tax-free savings.

On the bright side, many retailers offered special sales and coupons last year to try to make up for not having a tax-free weekend. In addition, many retailers claim that special store-specific discounts are better anyway because people still will shop and the city will benefit by receiving the sales tax.

Moreover, if stores offer deals such as "10 percent off storewide merchandise," then shoppers won't have to deal with pesky tax-free exemption lists, which prevent certain best sellers — like jewelry, premium denim, shoes and many electronics — from being purchased tax-free.

Fort Stewart schedule includes Thursday early dismissals

Fort Stewart DoDEA schools will let out students early every Thursday during the 2011-12 school year. Instead of 2:45 p.m., students will be released at 1:30 p.m.

The early dismissals will provide more time for teachers to attend meetings, improve personal development and collaborate.

For preschoolers, the dismissal times will move up to 10 a.m. from 10:40 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. from 2:45 p.m.

In a letter sent to families earlier this year, Fort Stewart officials said other schools with similar dis-

missal schedules — including those at Fort Benning and Fort Bragg — have produced positive results.

The early dismissals also give parents more time to spend with their children. Additionally, students can use the extra time to participate in tutoring opportunities or join a club or sport.

Also, keep in mind that Fort Stewart schools have different starting and ending dates than Liberty County schools. Fort Stewart schools start Aug. 8 and end May 25. School registration is from 8 a.m.-noon Tuesdays through Thursdays.

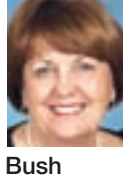

School Uniform Dress Code

In the interest of improved student performance, school safety, a reduction in student disruptions, and improved student self esteem, the Liberty County Board of Education has enacted a mandatory uniform dress code policy for all students in kindergarten through grade twelve. School administrators will be responsible for making final determinations as to whether a student's attire or appearance is in conflict with the written procedures.

Elementary Dress Code Procedures

The following clothing styles and colors will be considered appropriate:

1. Solid navy or khaki pants, skirts, jumpers with approved tops, skirts (skirts with shorts), and shorts are allowed. Shorts, skirts, jumpers, and skirts must not be more than three inches above the top of the knee cap.
2. Only solid white or navy polo shirts (no ruffles, lace, elastic, or smoking) will be allowed. Blouses and button down shirts are no longer allowed. One additional color has been chosen by each school

School colors:

Red: Button Gwinnett Elementary, Joseph Martin Elementary, Lyman Hall Elementary
Burgundy: Frank Long Elementary
Hunter Green: Jordye Bacon Elementary
Gold: Liberty Elementary, Waldo Pafford Elementary,
Baby/Light Blue: Taylors Creek Elementary
 Please contact the school for the exact shade of each color

Uniforms must also abide by the following guidelines:

1. Shirts may have a school insignia, but no other ornamentation, including labels, are allowed on any clothing; (Buttons and tabs that are part of the garment when purchased are not considered ornamentation);
2. Shirts must be tucked;
3. No denim, knit pants, jogging or cargo pants, or "skinny" pants, or skater pants;
4. Uniforms must be made of a standard uniform material such as cotton or twill;
5. No zippers on pockets or pant legs;
6. Shorts and pants cannot have pockets on the legs; and
7. Uniforms must be worn at the natural waist. They can not be poorly fitted or oversized and baggy, so as to allow sagging of the pants. Belts must be worn if pants, skirts, or shorts have belt loops. If belts have buckles, they must not be oversized nor have any writing that is considered offensive.

Accessories

1. Shoes must be enclosed and fastened/tied properly;
2. Solid color sweaters or sweat-shirts without hoods and without an insignia (color appropriate to the school) may be worn over uniform shirts;
3. Coats and jackets must be worn open in the building;
4. White, gray, or black T-shirts, or a color appropriate to the school, may be worn under uniform shirts. Solid colored turtlenecks (white or a color appropriate to the school) may be worn under uniform shirts;
5. No manner of clothing, jewelry, button, or pin may display drugs, cigarettes, sexually suggestive items, alcohol, profanity, gang related logos or messages, or pictures or words that are determined to be distracting or demeaning to others by the

school's administrators;

6. Hats, caps, sweatbands, bandannas, sunglasses, and other head coverings inside the building are not permitted;
7. Pierced earrings are permissible when worn in the earlobes as designed. Other body piercing are not permitted to be visible at school. Students may not wear at school items such as nose rings, nose pins, tongue rings, tongue pins, or any jewelry to accessorize facial or body piercings;
8. Extreme color/hairstyles, make-up, etc. must not be a distraction, immodest, inflammatory, or offensive;
9. Chains, wallet chains, and spiked jewelry are not allowed on campus or school related activities;
10. Only tights, hose, leggings, or socks may be worn under uniforms. Tights, hose, leggings, and socks must be a solid color; No designs may be worn; and
11. Students enrolled in the STAR program or JROTC will be permitted to wear approved uniforms.

Dress Down Days

School administrators will be able to occasionally allow "Dress Down Days" as a motivator or reward. Dress on these days should follow the Liberty County Dress Policy for dress down days as listed in the Code of Conduct. "Dress Down Days" should not be held during the first nine weeks of the school year (with the exception of school picture day). School administrators will also have the authority to allow groups to modify their dress on given days to allow for special programs and/or situations. This could include cheerleaders, sports teams, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, etc.

Liberty County Elementary Dress Code Requirements for Dress Down Days

1. Shoes must be worn at all times for health and safety reasons. The following are not permitted: shoes which damage the carpet or floors, bedroom shoes, flip flops, shoes with wheels, or shoes with heels over 1 ½ inch in length;
2. Hats, caps, sweatbands, and sunglasses worn inside the building are not permitted except on specified days or particular situations as determined by the school's administrators;
3. Halter tops, midriffs, muscle shirts, net shirts, cutaways, pajamas, lounging pants, clothing with words across the seat, or any garment that shows the stomach or waistline in the back are not permitted;
4. Sleeveless tops must have a strap of at least two (2) inches in width across the shoulders. Revealing necklines are not permitted;
5. Spandex clothing and sheer garments worn as the primary garments are not permitted;
6. Pants must be worn at the natural waist. They cannot be poorly fitted or oversized nor have any writing that is considered offensive;
7. Clothing with suggestive words or pictures are not permitted;
8. Overalls must be fastened;
9. Bicycle shorts are not permitted;
10. Shorts and skirts must not be more than three inches above the top of the kneecap.
11. Shorts must be worn under skirts when the child is participating in rigorous physical activity;
12. Clothing that is torn, ripped, or unhemmed either by accident or style is not permitted;
13. Extreme color/hairstyles, make-up, etc., must not be a distraction,

immodest, inflammatory, or offensive;

14. Pierced earrings are permissible when worn in the earlobes as designed. Tattoos and other body piercings are not permitted to be visible at school. Students may not wear at school items such as nose rings, nose pins, tongue rings, tongue pins, or any jewelry to accessorize facial or body piercings; and,
15. No manner of clothing, jewelry, button, or pin may display drugs, cigarettes, sexually suggestive items, alcohol, profanity, gang related logos or messages, or pictures or words that are determined to be distracting or demeaning to others by the school's administrators.

School Dress Code Closets

Each school will maintain a uniform dress closet. This closet will contain a variety of sizes of uniforms for students who are newly enrolled or are noncompliant. **Newly Enrolled Students** Students newly enrolled in the school system will be given ten (10) school days to adequately prepare for the dress code policy. Until that time they may borrow uniforms from the Uniform Dress Closet without penalty. However, students must wear a school uniform each day.

Noncompliance Procedures

Each school will strive to achieve full compliance within the guidelines of the Uniformed Dress Code Policy. Since non compliance interferes with the smooth operation of the school, the plan listed below has been developed to address students who do not comply with the required dress code procedures. If a student comes to school out of uniform, the following measures will be taken. A uniform will be provided to the student which will be returned at the end of the day as well as:

- 1st Occurrence** ~ The teacher will send home a letter from the administration.
- 2nd Occurrence** ~ The teacher will send home a letter from the administration and call the parent or guardian.
- 3rd Occurrence** ~ A conference will be set up between an administrator and the parent to address the problem and develop a solution.
- 4th Occurrence** ~ School officials will administer punishments as set up under Level I in the Code of Conduct.
- 5th & Additional Occurrences** ~ School officials will administer punishments as set up under Levels I or II in the Code of Conduct.

Middle/High School Dress Code Procedures

The following clothing styles and colors will be considered appropriate:

1. Solid khaki pants and skirts no shorter than 3 inches above the knee. Shorts and pants cannot have pockets or zippers on the legs. **Each school is allowed one additional color choice of pants, skirts, or shorts. Liberty County High School may also wear black, and Bradwell Institute, Lewis Frasier Middle School, Midway Middle School and Snelson Golden Middle School may also wear navy blue.**
2. Jumpers (sleeveless and of khaki color) worn with a shirt or blouse already specified in the dress code will be acceptable.
3. Solid white polo or collared shirts and blouses will be allowed. One additional color has been chosen by each middle or high school.

School Colors:

Royal Blue: Bradwell Institute
Black: Liberty County High and Midway Middle School
Gold: Snelson Golden Middle
Red: Lewis Frasier Middle
 Please contact the school for the exact shade of each color.

Uniforms must also abide by the following guidelines:

1. Shirts may have a school insignia, but no other ornamentation is allowed on any clothing;
2. Shirts must be tucked in and with no cleavage visible.
3. No denim, jogging, "skinny" pants, skater pants, or cargo pants, leggings, or material containing spandex (Lycra)
4. Uniforms must be made of a standard uniform material such as cotton or twill; and have a sewn hem.
5. No zippers or pockets on pant legs; and,
6. Uniforms must be worn at the natural waist. They cannot be poorly fitted, tight, body hugging, or oversized and baggy, so as to allow sagging of the pants. Belts must be worn if pants or skirts have belt loops. Belts must be solid and unadorned navy, black, brown. white, or khaki. Belts and belt buckles must not be oversized nor have any writing or symbols.

Accessories

1. Shoes must be enclosed at the front and fastened/tied properly. Shoes must be a matched pair. Shoes with wheels are not allowed. Bedroom shoes and slippers are not allowed.
2. Solid color sweaters or sweat-shirts without hoods and without an insignia (color appropriate to the school) may be worn over uniform shirts;
3. Coats and jackets must be left in the student's locker during the school day;
4. White, gray, or black T-shirts, or a color appropriate to the school, may be worn under uniform shirts. Solid color turtlenecks (white or a color appropriate to the school) may be worn under uniform shirts;
5. No manner of clothing, jewelry, button, or pin may display drugs, cigarettes, sexually suggestive items, alcohol, profanity, gang related logos or messages, or pictures or words that are determined to be distracting or demeaning to others by the school's administrators;
6. Hats, caps, sweatbands, sunglasses, and other head coverings inside the building are not permitted. These items are only allowed outside the building and must not obscure the person's identity. Bandannas are not allowed on school property.
7. Pierced earrings are permissible when worn in the ear as designed. Other body piercings are not permitted to be visible at school. Students may not wear at school items such as nose rings, nose pins, tongue rings, tongue pins, or any jewelry to accessorize facial or body piercings;
8. Extreme hair color/hairstyles, make-up, etc., must not be a distraction, inflammatory, or offensive. Facial hair must be neatly trimmed;
9. Chains, wallet chains, and spiked jewelry are not allowed on campus or at school related activities;
10. Only tights, hose, or socks may be worn. Tights and socks must be solid black, tan, navy, or white. No hose with designs may be worn; and
11. Students enrolled in the STAR program or JROTC will be permitted to wear approved program

uniforms.

Dress Down Days

School administrators will be able to occasionally allow "Dress Down Days" as a motivator or reward. Dress on these days should follow the Liberty County Dress Policy for dress down days as listed in the Code of Conduct. "Dress Down Days" should not be held during the first month of a school year (with the exception of school picture day). School administrators will also have the authority to allow groups to modify their dress on given days to allow for special programs and/or situations. This could include cheerleaders, sports teams, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, etc.

All teachers will enforce the above items on a daily basis each period. Should a student not be in compliance with the dress code, he/she will be required to comply before returning to class. All students must comply with the above dress code for the entire school day including during physical activity time, during PE, JROTC, etc. This includes cheerleaders/dance team, flag corps, and other groups except during performances.

Violation of the dress code will result in a Level I or Level II Discipline depending upon the severity and frequency of the offense.

Middle School and High School Dress Code Requirements for Dress Down Days

1. Shoes must be worn at all times, tied securely, and firmly anchored to the feet. No shower shoes, bedroom shoes, shoes with wheels, slippers, or roller blades are allowed;
2. Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in even if they are not tucked in (no bare midriffs);
3. No manner of clothing, jewelry, button, or pin may display drugs, cigarettes, sexually suggestive items, alcohol, profanity, gang related logos or messages, or pictures or words that are determined to be distracting or demeaning to others by the school's administrators;
4. All shirts/dresses/tops must be fitted around the arm so that undergarments are not exposed. The width of the strap over the shoulder must be at least two (2) inches. No low-cut, revealing shirts are allowed;
5. Hats, caps, sweatbands, bandannas, sunglasses, and other head coverings inside the building are not permitted;
6. Spandex clothing is not permitted;
7. Shirts and pants must be free of deliberate holes and tears;
8. Shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be non-body hugging, have a sewn hem, and must not be more than three inches above the top of the kneecap. Splits in skirts must

follow the same rule;

9. Facial hair must be neatly trimmed;
10. Pants must be worn at the natural waist. They cannot be poorly fitted or oversized and baggy, so as to allow sagging of the pants. Belts must be worn if pants, skirts, or shorts have belt loops. Belt buckles must not be oversized nor have any writing that is considered offensive;
11. Sheer garments are not permitted;
12. If pants, shorts, or skirts have straps which fit over the shoulders, the straps must be fastened in front and back of clothing and must be worn on the shoulders;
13. Pierced earrings are permissible when worn in the earlobes as designed. Tattoos and other body piercings are not permitted to be visible at school. Students may not wear at school items such as nose rings, nose pins, tongue rings, tongue pins, or any jewelry to accessorize facial or body piercings;
14. Extreme color/hairstyles, make-up, etc., must not be a distraction, immodest, inflammatory, or offensive; and,
15. Chains, wallet chains, and spiked jewelry are not allowed on campus or at school related activities.

Middle and High School: School Dress Code Closets

Each school will maintain a uniform dress closet. This closet will contain a variety of sizes of uniforms for students who are newly enrolled.

Middle and High School: Newly Enrolled Students

Students newly enrolled in the school system will be given ten (10) school days to prepare adequately for the dress code policy. Until that time they may borrow uniforms from the Uniform Dress Closet without penalty. However, students must wear a school uniform each day.

Middle and High School: Non-compliance Procedures

Each school will strive to achieve full compliance within the guidelines of the Uniform Dress Code Policy. Since non-compliance interferes with the smooth operation of the school, the plan listed below has been developed to address students who do not comply with the required dress code procedures. If a student is not in compliance with the dress code, the following measures will be taken.

- 1st Occurrence** ~ Referral for after school office detention AND either ISS or fix problem;
- 2nd Occurrence** ~ Referral for one day Saturday school AND either ISS or fix problem;
- 3rd Occurrence** ~ Assignment to ISS for three additional days AND either ISS or fix problem;
- 4th & Additional Occurrences** ~ 1 day of OSS for each occurrence AND either ISS or fix problem.

The Liberty County School System prohibits the possession of electronic devices, including cellular phones, during the school day.

All students shall be prohibited from using any electronic devices during the operation of a school bus, including but not limited to, cellular phones, pagers, audible radios, tape or compact disc players, or any other electronic device that might interfere with the school bus communication equipment or the school bus driver's operation of the school bus.

Liberty County Schools/District will not be responsible for investigating or replacing/reimbursing lost or stolen communication devices.
